## **Do's and Don'ts**



## When talking about transition age foster youth ...

Don't	Do
Use transition age youth without defining it or including the word "foster."	Include the word "foster" up front or give a clear definition of who these youth are.
Just describe racial disparities in the foster care system.	Be explicit about how inequities like racial discrimination shape the experiences of foster youth.
Focus solely on vulnerability and risk.	Talk about healthy development and wellbeing.
Focus on permanent damage and trauma.	Start with opportunity and community.
Just highlight individual stories of overcoming the odds or falling through the cracks.	Use the "Steep Climb" and "Plugged In" metaphors to talk about how to support foster youth.
Talk about transition age foster youth as uniquely troubled.	Talk about similarities to other adolescents' needs and supports.
